Why go? Culture & History & Customs

Chengdu, founded by the settlers 3200 years ago. At first the name of Chengdu was from a history book written in 1st century "it takes 1 year to make a county, 2 years to make a city, 3 years to make a metropolis" so here's the origin of Chengdu (means "became a metropolis" in Chinese).

In 3rd century, Chengdu was famous for its Lotus, so it is also called "Furong Cheng", means "the city of Lotus"

Chengdu, as well as Sichuan Province, is famous for Spicy Sichuan Food, such as Mapo tofu and hot pot, it is worth a try!

Local Price

Restaurant

Most prices in Chengdu is cheap, one dish of noodle in common restaurant won't more than 8 yuan, the street stalls common price won't more than 4 yuan. And middle or higher Restaurant costs 100 yuan and above for one person.

Accommodation

One night in international Youth Hostel is 50 yuan or so, and common accommodation costs 150 yuan for one person, middle or higher accommodation cost 500 yuan and above.

Bus

The fare of bus is unified for 2 yuan, and you must take some coins because it's self-service ticketing.

Taxi

Basically taxi's flag-fall price is 8 yuan for 2 km (and adds 1 yuan for gas bill), after 2 km, the price for each km is 1.9 yuan, from 10 km to 60 km is 2.85 yuan/km. At night time taxi's flag-fall price become 9 yuan for 2 km, and after 2 km is 2.2 yuan/km, from 10 km to 60 km is 3.3 yuan/km. Besides, Premium taxi adds 1 yuan than common taxi

Subway


Subway's flag-fall price is 2 yuan, and when goes over 6 or 7 stations adds 1 yuan, whole line costs 5 yuan.

Private car

Huo San Lun, means "Fire 3-wheels", is a popular transportation among people in Chengdu, flag-fall price's around 3-6 Yuan, but few of them could speak English, take care when you take.







the best season to travel

The best season of travel is spring and autumn, but you'd better avoid Chinese public holidays, In public holidays, all the Scenic spot will be filled by tourists so you won't have a good experience.

And Chengdu city is based at Sichuan Basin, so the weather is always wet and foggy, and muggy at summer.



















Story

Sight2: Dujiangyan Dam (都江堰)



Story

The Dujiangyan Dam, 45km north of Chengdu, is an ancient technological wonder of the country. More than 2000 yers ago, Li Bing(250–200BC), as a local governor of the Shu State, designed this water control and irrigation dam and organized thousands of local people to complete the project to check the Mingjiang River. For many years the river, flooded the Chengdu agricultural area and local farmers suffered a lot from the water disaster. Due to the success of the project, the dam automatically diverts the Mingjiang River and channels it into irrigation canals. For many years the dam has continued to make the most of the water conservancy works.

Sight3: Wuhou Shrine (武侯祠)

Story

Situated in the south suburb of Chengdu, Wuhou Ci / Wuhou Shrine covers an area of 3.7 hectares. It is dedicated to the memory of both Liu Bei (161 – 223), Emperor of the Kingdom of Shu in the Three Kingdoms period (220 – 280), and Zhuge Liang (181 – 234), Prime Minister of the Kingdom.

After the Han Dynasty collapsed in the early 3rd century, the state was divided into three kingdoms, Wei, Shu, and Wu. Competing to reunify the country, the three were locked in war, leaving behind many famous historical remains and tales of heroism.

Sight4: Jinli Promenade (锦里)



Right next to the Wuhouci Memorial Temple is Jinli Promenade, a rebuilt trading and folk art street imitating the ancient—style buildings in West Sichuan. "Jinli" is the name of an old street in Han—dynasty Chengdu, meaning "make perfection still more perfect and hide the universe in the universe". The ancient Jinli was one of the oldest and the most commercialized streets in the history of West Shu and had been well—known throughout the country in Qin, Han, and Three–kingdom cultures as its soul, the social style of Ming and Qing dynasties as its appearance, the West Sichuan folkways and customs as its body, the new Jinli Promenade, condensed the essence out of the worldly life in Chengdu: teahouses, inns, restaurants, bars, theatrical stages, handicrafts, local snacks and specialties.



During the An Lushan-Shi Siming Rebellion(the most destructive rebellion in Chinese history, over 10 million people died). Du Fu, one of the most famous Tang Dynasty poets and the "Sage of Chinese Poems", took refuge in Chengdu from Chang'an (now Xi'an). With the help from his friends, the thatched cottage was built by the Huanhua Stream on the west suburbs of Chengdu, where he spent four years of his life and produced more than 240 poems oft-quoted and widely loved. From Song Dynasty, people started to construct gardens and halls on the site of his thatched cottage to honor him and pay him respects. The Cottage itself is a solemn and serene landscape, in which the memorial buildings are elegantly simple, close to a commoner's house, yet in their accommodation there is a very large collection of different editions of Du Fu's poems and other relics.

Sight7: Jinsha's Site & Museum (金沙遗址)



Story

Jinsha Site Museum is a significant relic of the ancient Shu civilization discovered in recent years. It is conside —red to be the anicient civilization center along Yangtze River and dates back to 12th to 7th century B.C. (the similar ages with Greeks). From the remains of buildings and a great deal of jade, pottery, and gold ware excav—ated there, we can draw the primary conclusion that t—he site used to be the capital of the ancient Shu King—dom more than 3,000 years ago. Jinsha Site Museum and Sanxingdui Museum become the holy land for scho—lars and tourists who are interested in Chinese civiliza—tion. The pattern of the Saint Sun Birds unearthed in Jinsha ruins has been selected as the logo of China C—ultural Heritages.

Story

Wenshuyuan (Wenshu Monastery) stands in the northern part of Chengdu City. nitially built in the Tang Dynasty (618 – 907), Wenshuyuan was once called Xinxiang Monastery. In 1681, during the reign of Emperor Kangxi of the Qing Dynasty (1644 – 1911), Cidu, an accomplished Buddhist monk, came to the monastery. He built a simple hut between two trees and for several years lived an ascetic life there. Legend has it when Cidu was being cremated; the statue of Wenshu (Bodhisattva Manjusri in Sanskrit) appeared in the flames, staying for a long time. So people regarded Cidu as the reincarnation of the Bodhisattva Manjusri. Thereafter. Xinxiang Monastery became Wenshuyuan.

Sight12: Green Goat Palace (青羊宮)



Qing Yang Gong Temple (Green Goat Palace) is the oldest and largest Taoist temple in the Southwest of China, It is situated in the western portion of Chengdu City. Originally built in the early Tang Dynasty (7th century), this temple has been rebuilt and repaired many times. The existing buildings were mostly built during The Qing Dynasty(19th century)

According to legend, Qing Yang Gong was said to be the birth place of the founder of Taoism. Lao Tsu. and is where he made the first sermon about Taoism. Ever since Taoism was established, this temple was said to be holy place for immortals to get together. According to recorded history, this temple was visited by two emperors of the Tang Dynasty. The temple was named by one of these two emperors. Because

of this, Qing Yang Gong is regarded as a cultural and historical site of great importance in Chengdu.

Mount Qingcheng is at 65km west of Chengdu, and it is one of the ancient cradles of Taoism. The mountain has numerous Taoist temples and sites along the paths to its peak. The area is green all year round and is known for its secluded tranquility. Jianfu Temple (Jianfu Gong) sits at the base of the mountain and is a large, well—preserved Daoist temple from the Tang Dynasty. About halfway up the mountain sits Tianshi Cave (Tian—shi Dong) the temple and school of Zhang Daolin, a famous Daoist master who taught here and contributed greatly to spreading Daoism in China. The present Tianshi Cave buildings were built at the end of the Qing Dynasty. Lastly, near the peak sits Shangqing Temple, which was originally established in the Jin Dynasty, while the current temple buildings are Qing Dynasty constructions.

Eating: Sichuan Cuisine

Sichuan Cuisine, known often in the West as Szechuan Cuisine, is one of the most famous Chinese cuisines in the world. Characterized by its spicy and pungent flavor, Sichuan cuisine, prolific of tastes, emphasizes on the use of chili. Pepper and prickly ash also never fail to accompany, producing typical exciting tastes. Besides, garlic, ginger and fermented soybean are also used in the cooking process. Wild vegetables and animals are usually chosen as ingredients, while frying, frying without oil, pickling and braising are applied as basic cooking techniques. It cannot be said that one who does not experience Sichuan food ever reaches China.

Hot Pot (火锅)



In the past, the boatmen by the Yangtze frequently lodged at the dock for night. Once they pulled in, they began to make a fire for dinner and getting warm. Their cooker was just a pot that held some water and vegetables added with flavorings such as hot pepper and pepper for dispelling da —mp (a saying goes like this: vegetables can serve as food while hot pepper kills cold). When the boatmen finished the "feast", they would gain spirit again. Later, the dish was spr —ead to all piers along the Yangtze River. Some people even began to name the hotpot as "hot potted landscape", "flavor in pot" and "hot happiness".

Chuanchuanxiang Stick (串串香)




It is a kind of spicy hot snack, somewhat like hot pot. Sliced raw meats, edible offal's (entrails and internal organs), and vegetables are impaled on bamboo skewers, and we should dip them into a pan with boiling spicy soup mounted above a heating device. The price is also fantastic: 0.2—1 Yuan per one.

Fuqi Fei Pian (Pork Lungs in Chili Sauce 夫妻肺片)



The original of the dish is about 70 years before, a couple called Zhang and Guo were using tender Beef, spicy beef ,as well as lungs of a cow making a mixture with hot pepper.

Dandan Noodles (担担面)



Dandan noodles or Dandanmian is a classic dish originating from Chinese Sichuan cuisine. It consists of a spicy sauce containing preserved vegetables (often including zha cai, lower enlarged mustard stems, or ya cai,, upper mustard stems), chili oil, Sichuan pepper, minced pork, and scallions served over noodles.

Mapo's Tofu (麻婆豆腐)



Founded in 1862. One Store owner called Mapo was quite famous in Chengdu at that time. She was good at cooking the domestic dishes of Sichuan, particularly make the bean curd and she had a set of special cooking technique then became famous by praises till now. It also spreads its fame from home to the outside world and gets both domestic and international hearties gourmets' complement.

Ye Er Ba (Lotus Leaf Harrow 叶儿粑)

A representative snack in Chengdu. From the outlook could we see Ye Er Ba was a yellow flour revolved in one piece of Lotus Leaf, looks like ears of a baby(that is also the origin of the name, Ye Er Ba literally means "Ears in lotus leaf"). After steamed of 10 minutes, the harrow melts, and that is the best time to eat.

Liang Noodles (凉粉)

Liangfen, or Liang Noodles, is a kind of cuisine that is clearly with areal characteristics. There are 3 types of Liang Noodles mainly existed in Chengdu: the Sichuan Liang Noodles, the Hakka Noodles, and the "Happy" Liang Noodles. The noodles' mainly made from mung bean flour, and usually being crystal.

Tutou (Rabbit's head 兔头)

It is quite unique that people in Sichuan loved Tutou so much. It had been said the tradition of eating Tutou was from the tradition of the surrounding barbarians in Sichuan in ancient times. Nowadays Tutou become a famous yummy dish in Sichuan, but for Chinese outside Sichuan also think it is hard to enjoy. If it is possible, you can have a try.

Youcha (oil tea 油茶)

A spice of traditional breakfast in Chengdu and it is quite different from milk tea in other Asia countries. put mung bean flour with oil in a cup of tea and stir for 30 seconds, a cup of Youcha's made. It is not oily as imagined, actually in Chengdu, every morning you could see bands of people staying in line for a cup of Youcha.

Lengguoyu (Cold-pot Fish 冷锅鱼)



The Lengguoyu's also a famous Sichuanese cuisine and the hot flavor conquered stomachs of the mass. Actually it is not cold at all. Boiled fish with spice served in pot at first, then after about 30 minutes, the servant of the restaurant would put other ingredients into the pot and start to make a hot pot (here's the origin of "Cold-pot")

Douhua (Soft Tofu 豆花)

It is said that Douhua was invented by an Earl in Jin Empire of China (about 4th century), and people in Chengdu made giant improvements with it, nowadays became a cold dish before meal in Chengdu.

Feichang Noodle ("fatty intestine" Noodle 肥肠粉)

Not a common dish for people in Chengdu, though it is very delicious. In previous times that people in Chengdu could not afford having pork of other meat every day, so they found frying intestine with noodle became an economical cuisine for them, so the noodle was spread throughout Chengdu. Now in order that people would worry about the condition of intestine, restaurants usually make this dish in front of the gourmets.

Tihua (Pig's feet soup 蹄花)

In Chengdu, Tihua rice/ Lao
-ma' s Tihua are famous among
the locals, and it is a pretty good
cuisine for people in winter.



Niuwangmiao Noodles (牛王庙怪味面)

It is called "No.1 noodle in Chengdu", and a special taste from various materials made this noodle famous, with is out of words to express.

It's said that sause of the noodle is made of tomatoes but the exact material is still a mystery. People in Chengdu also put beef and Pork Intestines(as food) as toppings of the noodle.

Like Lan—celot and King Arthur in Britain, Zhang and Liu gradually became the symbol of loyalty and bravery. It is said that general Zhang was quite fond of beef, and himself was a good cook on beef, so Zhangfei's beef became a traditional snack in Sichuan. Now in Chengdu when you can see sellers on street dressing like an ancient Chinese, with black face and beard, that must be Zhangfei's Beef, have a try.
