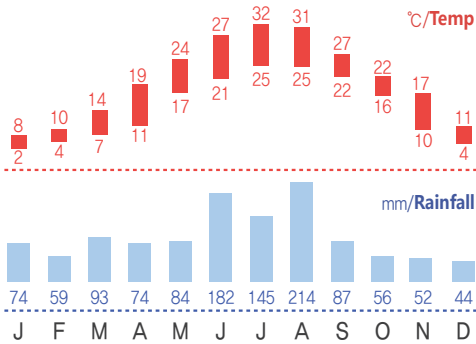

## Perennial temperature & Rainfall



### the best season to travel

It is better to travel in spring and autumn. In March–May, weather is pleasant around Shanghai, quite a good season for people to go for an outing; in September– November, it is better to be a gourmet when the famous local crabs grown. It is the hottest time in the month of mid Jul–Aug, average temperature in Shanghai is above 35°C. In Jun–Jul it is mold–rain season in Shanghai, do not forget to bring raingears with you.

## Transportation

### Metro

Starting Price: 3 Yuan

Distance within 6km - 3 Yuan; 6–16km - 4 Yuan; over 16km - 1 Yuan for every 10 km

### Metro tips

A 3–day ticket is available. Within 72 hours could users take any public transportations at any time. Ticket price is 45 Yuan and sold at ticket selling office of “Hongqiao Railway Station” metro station.

A 1 day ticket is available. Price is 18 Yuan for 24 hours after activated.

If taking a bus is not convenient for foreign visitors, taking a metro is suggested.

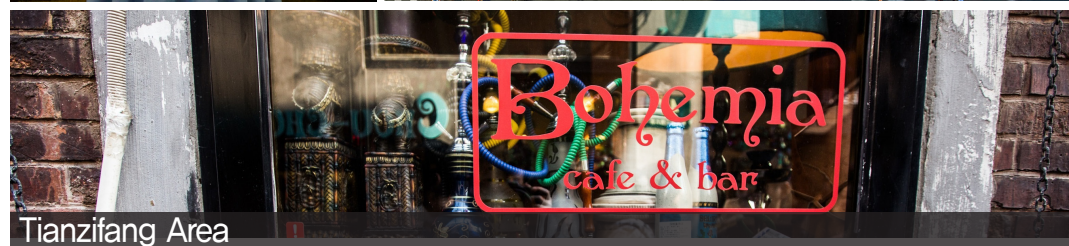

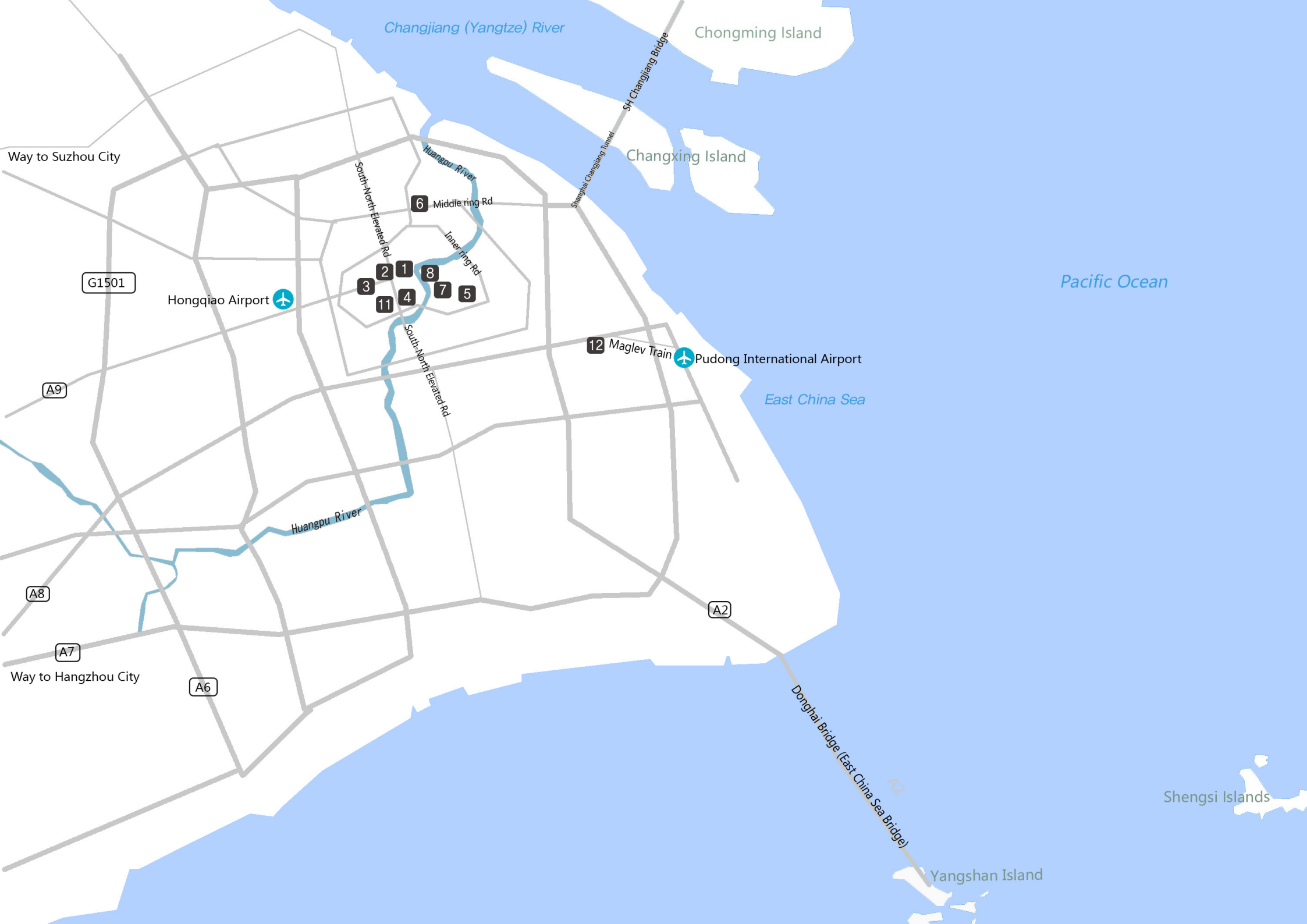

## Sight1: The Bund (外滩)



### Story

The Bund is a district in Shanghai where was lent to the British as concession in 1844. The area centres on a section of Zhongshan Road within the former Shanghai International Settlement, which runs along the western bank of the Huangpu River, facing Pudong, in the eastern part of Huangpu District. The Bund usually refers to the buildings and wharves on this section of the road, as well as some adjacent areas.

When lights are on in the evening, people could easily feel the old times of Shanghai.

It is a good choice to take a ferry to the other side of the Bund, at the ferry dock at East Jinling Rd. about 800 meters from the Bund.

There is sight-seeing canal for river crossing, passengers can take an escalator from the Bund

## Sight2: Nanjing Road Walkway (南京东路)



It is one of the world's busiest shopping streets, perhaps you have heard. Located in the city center, its history can be traced back to the year 1845. At that time it was called Park Lane, which stretched from the Bund to He'nan Road. In 1854, it was extended to Zhejiang Road, and eight years later, once more extended to Xizang Road. In 1862, it was named formally Nanking Road. After World War Two the government changed its name from Nanking Road to "East Nanjing Road", meanwhile they also renamed the former Bubbling Well Road "West Nanjing Road", and the general name of the two roads became "Nanjing Road", comprising five kilometres total length.

At the beginning of the 20th century, eight big department stores were established along the street. A series of franchised stores were also set up at that time. Now, located here are most of Shanghai's oldest and largest department stores, as well as a variety of domestic retail outlets, and some traditional eateries with a long history.

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## Sight3: Jing An Temple (静安寺)



Jing'an Temple is one of the most famous temples in Shanghai which is located at West Nanjing Road, the flourishing downtown area of Shanghai. In 1983, the temple was put on the list of key national protection. There were eight scenes in the former Jing'an Temple that previously enjoyed great popularity. Most of them are extinct but the Estavel (Yong Quan) which was in front of Jing'an Temple was excavated in May 5th, 2009. The spring water gushed out day and night, so people called it 'boil well'. It was regarded as the 'Sixth Spring under Heaven'. After reconstruction, the spring was relocated at the crossing of Huashan Road and West Nanjing Road, and regained its former charm.

Best Time for visit: before 9:00 in the morning, when the monks chant in the temple. And DO NOT fall into an easy victim to "Fortune-tellers" nearby.

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#### Sight4: City God's Temple (城隍庙)



City God's Temple (Cheng Huang Miao) is a major yet relatively inactive, Taoist temple in Shanghai. It is located in the area south of Yan'an Road on the Fangbang Zhong Road.

During the Ming Dynasty, the head of Shanghai County dedicated a temple to the local city god. Since then, the City God's Temple has been destroyed several times and the current temple was built in 1926. During the the war of resistance against Japanese invasion during World War II, local merchants built a new City God's Temple in the Foreign Concession (between Lianyun Road and West Jinling Road).

That area is now a highrise residence building. The "former" temple is known as the Old City God's Temple. The Old City God's Temple and the enclose Yuyuan are not only famous tourist sites but also popular shopping attractions. There are boutiques, shops selling local specialties, as well as large jewelry stores, department stores and fabulous local snack restaurants to be found here.

And also, the crab-brown flaky pastry(蟹黄包), mashed date flaky pastry (锅贴) are quite famous out there.

#### Sight5: Shanghai Science Museum (上海科技馆)



It is a large museum in Pudong District, close to Century Park, which is the largest park of the city. The museum covers an area of 68,000 square meters, a floor space of 98,000 square meters and an exhibition space of 65,500 square meters with planned visiting flow of 2,000,000 to 3,000,000 visitors per year.

Shanghai Science & Technology Museum opened to the public on December 18, 2001. The original design of the museum and its core exhibits was managed by Shanghai based high tech and multi-media firm Creative Star Digital.

1. Cradle of Designers: The Masterpieces of Design Area displays great achievements in design.

Includes a CAD-classroom.

2. Animal Hall: A hall with animal models, including a platypus, a beluga whale, a bearded vulture, a few lions, and a badger.

3. A large greenhouse with live turtles, plants, as well as lots of models, including a cave with bats. Also, it has a hall of live fish. Species include koi, golden carp and Chinese paddlefish.

4. An IMAX Theatre and IMAX Dome Theatre.

#### Sight6: Campus Town (大学城)



The famous campuses here are Fudan and Tongji University. Fudan University was founded in 1905, is one of the earliest modern Universities in China, and also, the top 10 scenery in Chinese Universities. Whoever want to experience the modern Chinese youth culture, cannot miss. And Tongji University,



was a medical school set by Germans at first, is famous for German literature and auto-machines, now there's German corner every week.

### Sight9: Madame Tussauds (杜莎夫人蜡像馆)



Madame Tussauds Shanghai has become famous throughout the world for its lifelike wax figures. Now, there are nearly 80 wax figures, including Yao Ming, Liu Xiang, David Beckham, Tom Cruise, Michael Jordan and Bill Clinton. Each costs more than a million yuan, and they are all elaborately made in the London studio that has more than 200 years of wax making experience. The completed figures are exhibited in seven Theme Pavilions——Behind the Scenes, charm of Shanghai, Historic Celebrities, Movies, Music, Sports and Speed. Behind the Scenes will show you how a wax statue comes into being. In the charm of Shanghai Pavilion, visitors can have an authentic experience of life in old Shanghai. The Historic Celebrities Pavilion shows legendary figures from history. In addition, Madame Tussaud's Shanghai will bring new wax figures into being from all walks of life.

### Sight10: Yuyuan Garden (豫园)



One of the top “Chinese cultural markets” with Panjiayuan/Liulichang in Beijing, Fuzimiao in Nanjing. There is a beautiful lotus pond. Across the pond is a bridge with a pavilion in the middle which is called the Mid-Lake Pavilion. It was rebuilt in 1784 and was converted into a teahouse 80 years ago. The old teahouse is one of the most famous in Shanghai, and was visited by Queen Elizabeth II and Bill Clinton among others.

The world first Maglev Train demonstration operation line – Shanghai Maglev Train, is from Pudong International Airport to Long Yang Road Metro Station, more than 30 kilometers takes only 6-7 minutes, with a speed of 430 km.

in every corner of the world. As for the local cuisine, Shanghainese Cuisine got its fame by sweet & fresh taste. Shanghainese Cuisine focuses on uses of soy sauce so a famous characteristic is that food looks bright

in plates. Dexing, Laozhengxing, Shanghai old Restaurant are the most famous ones in Shanghai locals eyes.

### Braised Jumbo Sea Cucumber with Shrimp Roe

虾子大乌参

Invented by a famous cook called Tsai Fok-hseng in 1920s, and became one of the representative of Shanghai cuisine. Quite good towards people because of the mineral materials, but European & American tourists seems not get used to its smell.

### Braised Pork Knuckle With Vegetates

草头圈子



Vegetates, or Caotou in Chinese, is a kind of vegetable grown in countryside near Shanghai. When people thought of pork knuckle, it was always with an oily image, but with vegetates absorbing the oil came out from the pork, the cuisine become balanced in taste.

### Braised Catfish with Soy Sauce

红烧鲶鱼



Catfish is a traditional Chinese cuisine, and braised catfish, though other parts of China also have this kind of dish but people in Shanghai pushed it to an altitude that no one could reach.



### Nanxiang Bun

南翔小笼包



A kind of Bun(Steamed Dumplings)that stands for Shanghai Cuisine. From the Annals of Jiading(formerly Shanghai):"Buns can be made with leavened or unleavened dough. Those made with unleavened dough uses clear water for mixing, the skin is thin and the fillings large. It is frequently made in Nanxiang, but is imitated elsewhere, calling it "Nanxiang style"

### Stir-fried shredded eel with hot oil

响油鳝糊



Literal meaning of the dish is "Sounding Oil Atop Braised Eel Shreds", is when the dish is delivered but people could still hear the sound from the hot oil.

The best season to have this is in summer.

### Diced meat and vegetable with chili sauce 八宝辣酱



A kind of chili sauce made from 8 kind of delicacies. Spicy but sweet, a good mate with rice.

### Scallion-stuffed Sesame Biscuit 蟹壳黄



Literal means “Crab shell yellow” in Chinese, because the color & shape is like a crab shell, and Shanghai in early times, there was an oven in every tea house, baking biscuits for guests, and finally it became a beloved snack in Shanghai.

### Fried Bean Curd noodle soup 油豆腐线粉汤

People in Shanghai have a habit that there have to be soup with biscuit or something else ,and this noodle soup became a sub-dish that never absences.

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### Bars & Clubs

There are many streets for bars in Shanghai.

#### 1. Hengshan Road 衡山路

Biggest bar street in Shanghai. As a card of the city, Hengshan Road became the most romantic one. Former as "Pétain Road" (in memory of the French general Henri Philippe Pétain) and then changed its name to Hengshan in 1943. Now Hengshan road are crowded with foreigners because of the nearby consulate area, and seized a special position in Shanghai's modern culture. The address is Metro Line 1 at Hengshan Road Station.

#### Recommended: Benny's Bar 贝尼酒吧

Opened in 1995, pretty classic bar in Hengshan Road. It is called "a country bar in the city", and decorations there make people feel like drinking in the woods. All kinds of drinks are served there, without minimum charge. Every day in 21:30-00:15 there are performances.

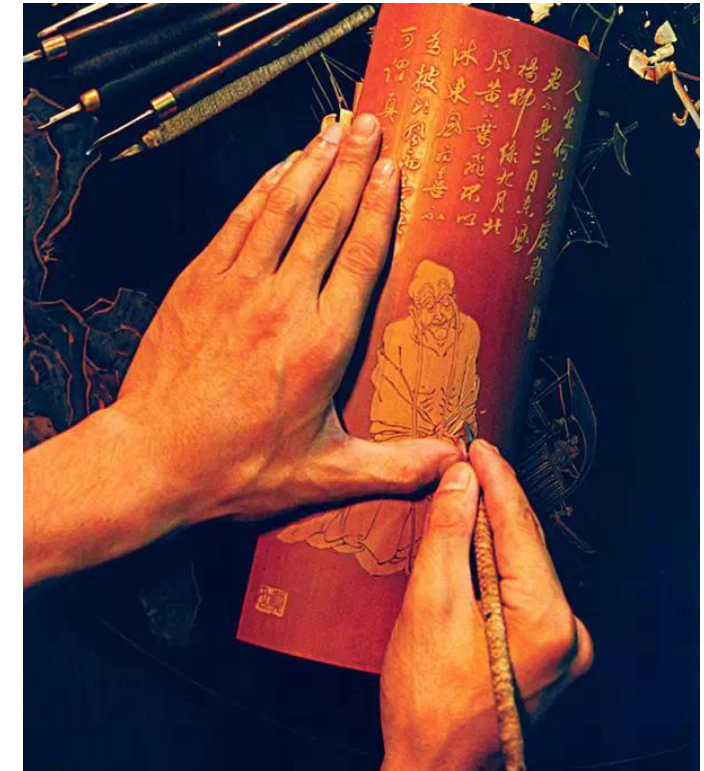
